SIP's continuum of care provides the following:

- Intensive case management
 - Referrals to medical, vision, psychiatric needs
 - Employment development
 - Resume building
 - Access to resources as needed
- Treatment and recovery services
 - Groups
 - Individuals
 - Crisis management
 - Individualized treatment planning
 - Recovery Services
- Housing support and services
 - Transitional Housing provided for up to two years while you are engaged in treatment services
 - Transitional Housing is provided in a fully furnished 2-bedroom apartment, rent is based on a **voluntary** donation of \$25/month if you are receiving income.
- Additional support services include:
 - Mental health services
 - Transportation, monthly bus passes are provided

Please call SIP @ 619-523-8121, you will be set up with a screening, if you are accepted SIP can provide transportation to the program. A background check will be completed prior to the screening, we screen for arson charges, sex crimes and violent crimes. Having any of the previously mentioned convictions will be discussed on a case-by-case basis. Do not wait until the last day of your stay to call SIP. The entire process from screening to admit can take several days to complete.



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
