The Transitional Employment Program (TEP/TE) is designed to reconnect our members to job opportunities through partnership with businesses in our community.

In addition to adding to the productivity of a business, TE jobs help members regain their purpose and further develop their skills.

The Transitional Employment Program is a fair and equal partnership between a business and a Clubhouse. A Clubhouse is a rehabilitation program for adults with mental health diagnoses who are striving to become more engaged and self-sufficient individuals in their community.

The Transitional Employment Program, a central component of the Clubhouse International Model, is designed to transition our members back into the workforce by providing employment opportunities through partnership with businesses.

WORKING TOGETHER

Members and staff engage in the Clubhouse work-order-day, working side by side while equally sharing the responsibilities of daily operations. Members choose their participation in either of the two Clubhouse Units. The Gray Unit focuses on employment, education, and administrative activities. The Blue Unit plans daily meals and performs hands-on tasks.

CLUBHOUSE TO EMPLOYER

Clubhouse Will:

- Screen the proposed job in advance to determine its suitability for Transitional Employment
- Ensure that our Job Placement Managers (Clubhouse staff) learn the job at no cost to the employer



EMPLOYER TO CLUBHOUSE

Employer Will:

- Offer employment opportunities at wages equal to that of others having essentially the same responsibilities
- Consult with Job Placement Managers before making substantial changes in job description
