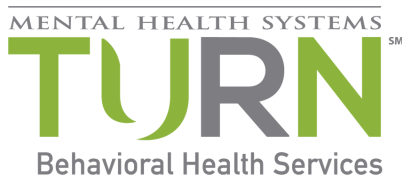

TURN to Recovery's continuum of care provides the following:

- Intensive case management
 - Referrals to medical, vision, psychiatric needs
 - Employment development
 - Resume building
 - Access to resources as needed
- Treatment and recovery services
 - Groups
 - Individuals
 - Crisis management
 - Individualized treatment planning
 - Recovery Services
- Housing support and services
 - Interim Shelter provided while you are engaged in treatment services
 - The interim shelter accommodations are fully furnished 2-bedroom apartments
- Recovery Residences, these beds will be charged at 30% of your income
- Additional support services include:
 - Mental health services
 - Transportation, monthly bus passes are provided

To get started, call TURN to Recovery at 619-523-8121 for a screening. If accepted, transportation to the program is available. A background check will be conducted, focusing on arson, sex crimes, and violent crimes, with cases evaluated individually. It's important to call for a screening well before your stay ends, as the process can take several days.
